

## To Airport Security Personnel:

On the reverse you see two X-rays (a=view from above, b=side view) of a complete parachute, containing a CYPRES parachute emergency activation system. CYPRES is a Life Saving Device for Skydivers. Depending on the parachute container the X-ray on your screen may vary. All its components (e.g. measuring technique, electronics, battery, loop cutter, control unit, plugs, cables, casing) as well as the complete system contain parts and materials that are approved and allowed for cargo and passenger aircraft by FAA Great Britain, DOT USA, LBA Germany, DGAC France, FAA Australia, FAA New Zealand and are not subject to any transport regulations. Regulation for lithium-batteries on passenger aircraft's from 2015: The CYPRES IS NOT AFFECTED BY THIS REGULATION because

- battery cells contain only 0,99 g Lithium
- battery is entirely build into the CYPRES device.
