

To airport security personnel:

On the back you see two X-ray images (a=view from above, b=side view) of a complete parachute containing a CYPRES parachute emergency activation system. CYPRES is a life-saving device for skydivers. Depending on the parachute container the X-ray image on your screen may vary. All its components (e.g. measuring technology, electronics, battery, loop cutter, control unit, plugs, cables, housing) as well as the complete system contain parts and materials that are approved and permitted for cargo and passenger aircraft by FAA Great Britain, DOT USA, LBA Germany, DGAC France, FAA Australia, FAA New Zealand and are not subject to any transportation regulations (Declarations can be found at www.cypres.aero or scan the QR Code).

Regulation for lithium batteries in passenger aircraft from 2015: The CYPRES IS NOT AFFECTED BY THIS REGULATION because

- the battery cells contain only 0,99 g Lithium
- the battery is entirely built-in to the CYPRES device.
